### Purpose of Role

The Results Runner is a voluntary position with the responsibility to assist the Tournament Office Manager and the Tournament Media Manager with results information distribution on the days of the tournament.

The success of the tournament will be judged by the speed of the information distribution. It is essential that information is distributed in a timely manner to numerous constituent groups, including the Media, and this task will form the cornerstone of this role.

### Key Areas of Responsibility

- Distribute results to recipients in a timely and efficient manner
- Support the Tournament Office Manager, as required, in the distribution process
- Support the Media Functional Area as required
- Assist in other areas as required

### Key Outcomes

- The timely distribution of agreed match statistics and results to constituent groups

- Strong work ethic and an ability to work as part of a team
- The ability to approach the role with a flexible outlook as it will evolve during the tournament
